

## **Middlefield Dog Park**

The Middlefield Dog Owner's Group (Mi-DOG – pronounced My-DOG), in conjunction with Tyler Sibley, a Middlefield Boy Scout with an ambitious Eagle Scout project and the Town of Middlefield, have joined forces to raise the funds and supply the volunteer labor necessary to construct a beautiful, new dog park in Middlefield.

The park is located on the beautiful 75 acre open space parcel known as The King Property, nestled on Beseck Mountain. It will offer an opportunity for dogs to safely run leash-free, and owners to socialize with other dog owners. The park will consist of approximately one acre of woodland, enclosed with a continuous 5' tall chain link fence. There will be separate fenced areas for both large and small (or timid) dogs. Amenities will be included for both the dogs and the dog owners.

Mi-DOG is pleased to announce that they opened phase one of the dog park in March 2009. Phase one includes the transition area and small dog area. For now, all dogs can enjoy the small dog area. There is still 800 feet of fence to be installed for the large dog area, so we will need a tremendous amount of local support to finish the park.
